Slobodanka Krulj indicates that there is a greater awareness of mobilities

There are no academic obstacles anymore. All is settled in the learning agreement and vice-deans have more autonomy. Students are better selected : knowledge of foreign language+ study results + motivation are important. There are not only the Erasmus+ grants, there are also a lot of grants from Russia and China. In Erasmus+ a lot of universities prefer first staff mobility in order to explore further academic recognition of student mobility. There is excellent cooperation with Poitiers.

### Points of attention:

- Within the framework of the project there are no clear indicators about the progress of increasing number of student mobilities. The same goes for the number of project applications.

- The information for incoming and outgoing mobility is not on the website in English
- The rulebook for projects/ mobilities/ recognition should be available in English ( at least a summary)
- Equipment has been delivered. Invoice + proof of registration of in the inventory should follow as soon as possible.
