Presented 4 pilot projects :

- Erasmus+ Experience
Pilot template should be completed with more detailed info. Dates of presentation sessions should also be mentioned. Photos, program, presentation and list of participants should be sent to Nenad. Do not forget to add the logo of STINT + the link to the webpage of home university.
Very good to ask the students who have been abroad last year to return to the university for sharing their experiences with the candidates for the following academic year.
- Erasmus+ Experience for High School
Pilot template should be completed with more detailed info. Dates of visits to high schools should also be mentioned. Photos, program, presentation and list of participants should be sent to Nenad. Do not forget to add the logo of STINT+ the link to the webpage of home university.
Very valuable initiative to use international cooperation to attract more students from secondary schools.

- International Master specialization programme in the field of Health Care Science
A Master course in English will be developed to attract more foreign students. Very good. All documents including curriculum in English should have link with STINT logo.

- Scientific Expert International Conference on Nursing “ Nursing yesterday, today and tomorrow
First “ health” conference was in November 2017, second one will be in November 2019.
An abstract of the 2017 conference will be published very soon(STINT logo to be added).
Also here the template for pilot project should be completed more into detail.

Points of attention :

- Equipment has been delivered. Invoice in English will be asked for. Registration of equipment in university register will follow. Equipment will be used in classroom for international students and by ECTS faculty coordinators
- Strategy and rulebook have been adopted by the Quality Assurance Board of the University. Is adaption by Senate still necessary ?
- 2 final years of Master in wood processing (mechanical engineering) will be offered in parallel in English programme under the guidance of Bern university. Accent will be put on e-learning courses + dual learning. Official decision with STINT link should be sent to Nenad.
- Together with Italian Embassy was organised a conference with professors, companies, students and pupils. Also here evidence with STINT logo should be sent to Nenad.
- The proposal from Dzenan regarding recognition of qualifications will be quickly recognised by the government. Once it happened, evidence has to be sent to Nenad.
- Outcomes of all international projects are being presented to all staff members. Very good in view of sustainability of project results !

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
